

We aim to:

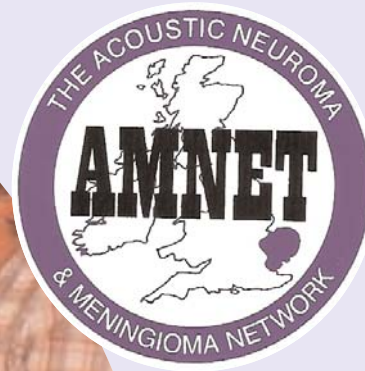
- bring patients together to share their experiences

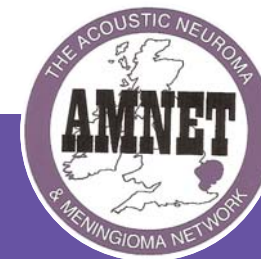
